Market surveillance Construction products

- Ministry of Infrastructure and Water Management (I&W)
- Ministry of the interior and Kingdom Relations (BZK)
- Distinction between policy making and surveillance activities
- Regulation 305/2011/EU (Construction products CPR) EU



Surveillance of Construction Products

- 9 inspectors: proactive and reactive surveillance activities
- 1 inspector: AdCo / contact with policy section
- Supported by a lawyer, network advisor, data-analist, investigation Service (OD) and others

Cooperation

- local authorities, associations, NEN, BZK, EZK, RVA, RVO, etc.
- EU Market surveillance authorities (MSA)

Project Cables 2019-2022

- motivation: New hEN (EN 50575) and EU joint initiative Administrative and testing
- Results so far; >100 product inspected (EU)
- Approx. 25% non conform







Project Smoke Alarms 2021-2022

- motivation: revised national regulation and high risk when failure
- Administrative and testing
- Approx. 50 products at 24 companies



Intervention

Administrative penalties

- Informing;
- Official warning;
- administrative order for periodic penalty payments;
- order for coercive administrative action.

Criminal offence (by valsheid in geschrifte)

- economic offence (e.g. falsification of documents) :
 - Official record by public prosecutor

Market Surveillance - EU

ILT - Participant of the ADCO CPR Group:

- Cooperation with EU Commission, GNB, EOTA,
 CEN, EU Associations
- Cross border cooperation MSA's
- Joint actions (Electrical cables, Vehicle restraint systems)
- Interpretation issues and best practices



EU tools to share information among MSA's:

- ICSMS (pass the baton, Safeguard clause, Market surveillance programs and strategies)
- RAPEX Rapid Exchange of products that present a risk



Market Surveillance Regulation 2019/1020

In force: 16 July 2021

- Replaces the market surveillance chapter of Regulation 765/2008
- EU harmonization legislation on non-food products: 70 pieces of legislation listed in Annex I → incl. Construction Products Regulation 305/2011
- lex specialis: provisions do not apply if already regulated in the product-specific legislation itself
- New definitions and powers to intervene in online sales
- More and better cooperation at national and EU level
- New economic operator (article 4)
- Legal establishment of ADCO Groups, MSA's, EU Product Compliance Network and Single liaison office
- Obligation to use the information sharing tools, like ICSMS
- Implementation in national legislation is still ongoing.



Regulation 2019/1020 - Article 4

Product may be placed on the market if there is a responsible economic operator established in the Union:

Manufacturer within the Union

Importer

Authorised representative

Fulfilment service provider

Applies to 18 product sectors, including Construction Products Regulation 305/2011

Revision of the CPR

ADCO CPR Group - WG 6

- Analysing the existing legislation on market surveillance applicable to construction products
- Revision of the CPR: proposal for a new chapter related to the market surveillance procedure
- ILT is member of WG 6 and commented the proposal

Other concerns:

- Harmonised standards are not up to date (CPD based, not in line with technical progress/ innovation)
- Expanding market for reused construction products
- Absence of specific test methods for market surveillance purposes
