- Preparatory phase – CPR Acquis (art 3a)
- Standardisation request (art 4)
- “Fallback” to standardisation (art 4a) (When standardisation fails)
- Product Requirements (art 5)

- Manufacturing obligations
- Obligations to take back unsold products
- Spare parts
- Possibility for COM to develop environmental labels



Life cycle assessments

- In accordance with EN15804
- Carbon emissions mandatory
- Additional indicators required (4-6 years after entry into force)
